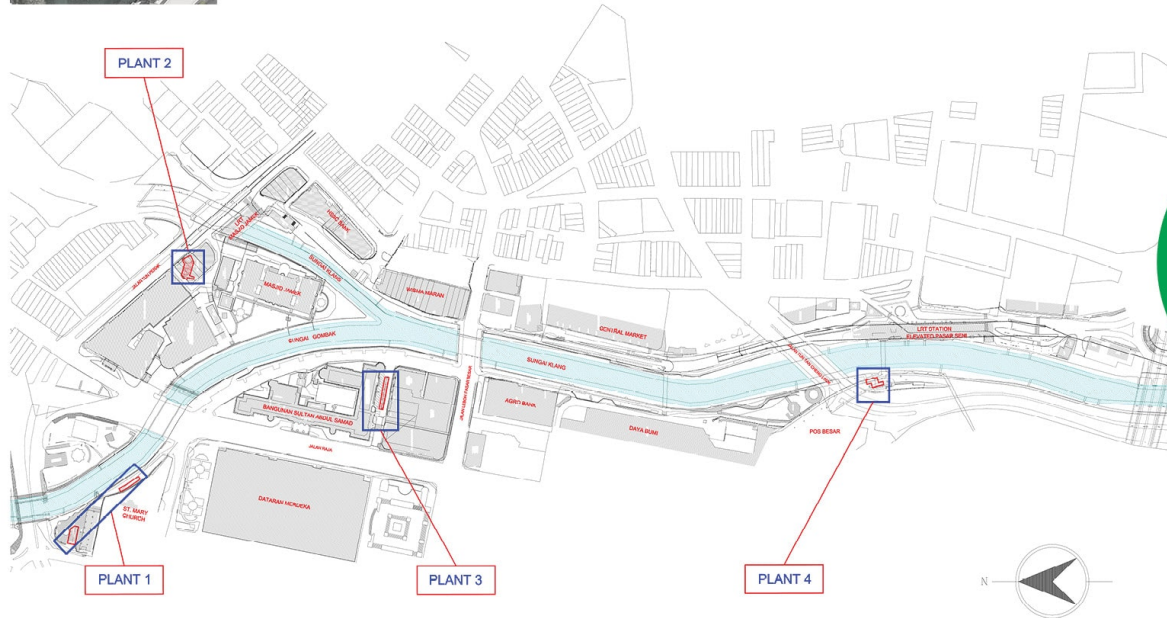




RIVER CLEANING - INTERCEPTOR SYSTEM

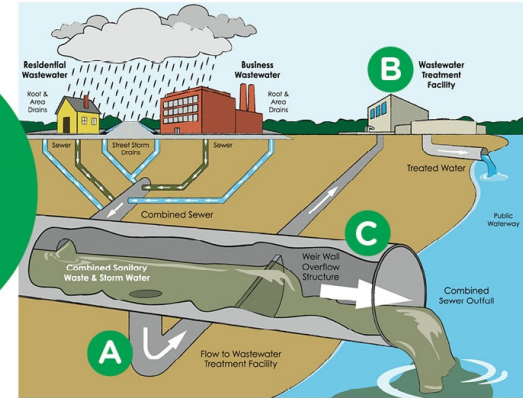


MAJOR SYSTEM COMPONENTS OF P7

- 4** Treatment Plants out of 11 in total
- 24** Combined Stormwater Outlets out of 47 in total
- 3** Pump Stations out of 40 in total
- 2.2** kilometres of pipeline out of 12km in total

HOW THE INTERCEPTOR SYSTEM WORKS

Class IIB water is discharged into the river from the treatment plants



The Interceptor pipes divert sillage and waste water from homes, commercial premises and buildings to treatment plants to be treated before being released as Class IIB water into the river.
